1. be - was / were - been

I **am** happy.

Yesterday I **was** tired.

I have **been** busy all week.

2. have - had - had

I usually **have** lunch with my friends.

Last week I **had** lunch alone.

I have never **had** lunch with my cousin.

3. do - did - done

I always **do** my homework.

Yesterday I **did** it quickly.

I have already **done** it today.

4. go - went - gone

I always **go** to school by bike.

Yesterday I **went** by bus.

I have never **gone** by plane before.

5. get - got - got / gotten

I always **get** up at 7.

Yesterday I **got** up at 6.

I have never **got** up late.

6. make - made - made

I usually **make** a few mistakes in tests.

Yesterday I **made** a lot of them.

I had never **made** so many mistakes before.

7. say - said - said

I always **say** hello to my friends.

Yesterday I **said** goodbye.

I have **said** sorry many times.

8. see - saw - seen

I often **see** my friends.

Yesterday I **saw** a rainbow.

I have never **seen** a whale.

9. take - took - taken

I **take** photos.

Yesterday I **took** one at school.

I have **taken** hundreds of pictures.

10. come - came - come

I usually **come** home at 4.

Yesterday I **came** late.

I have **come** here before.

11. think - thought - thought

I often **think** about holidays.

Yesterday I **thought** about exams.

I have **thought** of a new idea.

12. know - knew - known

I **know** the song.

Yesterday I **knew** the answer.

I have always **known** this rule.

13. find - found - found

I always **find** coins on the street.

Yesterday I **found** a key.

I have **found** my book.

14. give - gave - given

I often **give** my friend advice.

Yesterday I **gave** her chocolate.

I have **given** him a present.

15. tell - told - told

I always **tell** jokes.

Yesterday I **told** one at lunch.

I have never **told** a lie.

16. become - became - become

I **become** nervous before exams.

Yesterday I **became** tired.

I have **become** more confident.

17. show - showed - shown

I **show** my work to the teacher.

Yesterday I **showed** her my notebook.

I have **shown** my project many times.

18. leave - left - left

I **leave** home at 8.

Yesterday I **left** earlier.

I have never **left** my bag at school.

19. feel - felt - felt

I often **feel** happy.

Yesterday I **felt** nervous.

I have **felt** sick before.

20. put - put - put

I **put** sugar in my tea.

Yesterday I **put** milk in it.

I have **put** my bag on the chair.

21. eat - ate - eaten

I often **eat** pizza.

Yesterday I **ate** spaghetti.

I have never **eaten** sushi.

22. buy - bought - bought

I **buy** fresh bread every day.

Last week I **bought** a book.

I haven't **bought** the tickets yet.

23. catch - caught - caught

I **catch** the bus every morning.

Yesterday I **caught** a cold.

I have **caught** many fish in my life.

24. wear - wore - worn

I always **wear** comfortable clothes.
Yesterday I **wore** my new jacket.
I have never **worn** a wedding dress.

25. drink - drank - drunk

I **drink** tea in the morning.
Yesterday I **drank** coffee with milk.
I have never **drunk** champagne.

26. swim - swam - swum

I **swim** in the sea every summer.
Yesterday I **swam** in the pool.
I have **swum** across the river once.

27. hurt - hurt - hurt

I never **hurt** anyone's feelings.
Yesterday I **hurt** my knee.
I have **hurt** myself many times.

28. dream - dreamt - dreamt (może też być dreamed – dreamed)

I often **dream** about travelling.
Last night I **dreamt** about flying.
I have **dreamt** of being famous.

29. steal - stole - stolen

I never **steal** anything.
Yesterday someone **stole** my bike.
My phone has been **stolen** before.

30. build - built - built

I **build** things with my dad.
We **built** a treehouse last year.
They have **built** a bridge.

31. run - ran - run

I **run** in the park.
Yesterday I **ran** 5 kilometers.
I have never **run** a marathon.

32. shake - shook - shaken

I always **shake** hands with new people.
Yesterday I **shook** hands with my teacher.
I have never **shaken** hands with a celebrity.

33. lend - lent - lent

I often **lend** my friends money.
Yesterday I **lent** my brother five pounds.
I have **lent** money to many people before.

34. pay - paid - paid

I always **pay** for my lunch.
Yesterday I **paid** the bill at the restaurant.
I have **paid** too much for clothes before.

35. lose - lost - lost

I often **lose** my keys.
Yesterday I **lost** my wallet.
I have **lost** many things in my life.

36. meet - met - met

I often **meet** my friends after school.
Yesterday I **met** my cousin at the park.
I have **met** many interesting people.

37. ring - rang - rung

I always **ring** my grandma on Sundays.
Yesterday I **rang** her to say hello.
I have **rung** her three times this week.

38. sell - sold - sold

I sometimes **sell** old clothes online.
Yesterday I **sold** my bike.
I have **sold** many things this year.

39. sit - sat - sat

I usually **sit** next to my best friend.
Yesterday I **sat** by the window.
I have **sat** there many times before.

40. choose - chose - chosen

I always **choose** healthy food.
Yesterday I **chose** a salad for lunch.
I have **chosen** water instead of soda.

41. blow - blew - blown

I often **blow** out candles on birthdays.
Yesterday I **blew** up a balloon.
I have **blown** all the candles at my party.

42. draw - drew - drawn

I often **draw** in my sketchbook.
Yesterday I **drew** a picture of a cat.
I have **drawn** many animals before.

43. fall - fell - fallen

I sometimes **fall** when I run too fast.
Yesterday I **fell** in the playground.
I have **fallen** many times while skating.

44. drive - drove - driven

I sometimes **drive** my dad's car.
Yesterday I **drove** to the countryside.
I have **driven** many long distances.

45. feed - fed - fed

I always **feed** my dog in the morning.
Yesterday I **fed** the cat instead.
I have **fed** many animals at the zoo.

46. lay - laid - laid

I usually **lay** the table before dinner.
Yesterday I **laid** the table for my family.
I have **laid** the table hundreds of times.

47. fight - fought - fought

I sometimes **fight** with my brother.
Yesterday I **fought** with him about the TV.
We have **fought** many times but always make up.

48. fly - flew - flown

I often **fly** to Spain in summer.
Last year I **flew** there with my parents.
I have **flown** to many countries.

49. forget - forgot - forgotten

I often **forget** my homework.
Yesterday I **forgot** my English book.
I have **forgotten** many important things.

50. grow - grew - grown

I always **grow** plants in my garden.
Last year I **grew** tomatoes for the first time.
I have **grown** several flowers this spring.

51. hide - hid - hidden

I sometimes **hide** my phone from my brother.
Yesterday I **hid** it under the bed.
I have **hidden** it in many places before.

52. keep - kept - kept

I always **keep** my promises.
Yesterday I **kept** my word.
I have **kept** all my secrets.

53. speak - spoke - spoken

I often **speak** English at school.
Yesterday I **spoke** with my teacher.
I have **spoken** to many foreigners.

54. teach - taught - taught

I sometimes **teach** my sister new words.
Yesterday I **taught** her a song.
I have **taught** her many things.

55. throw - threw - thrown

I often **throw** the ball to my dog.
Yesterday I **threw** it very far.
I have **thrown** it hundreds of times.

56. win - won - won

I usually **win** at board games.
Yesterday I **won** the competition.
I have **won** many prizes before.

57. write - wrote - written

I often **write** in my diary.
Yesterday I **wrote** a letter to my friend.
I have **written** many stories this year.

58. ride - rode - ridden

I often **ride** my bike to school.
Yesterday I **rode** my bike in the park.
I have **ridden** horses before.

59. spend - spent - spent

I usually **spend** my pocket money on sweets.
Yesterday I **spent** ten dollars on a book.
I have **spent** a lot of time learning English.

60. sink - sank - sunk

He often **sinks** toy boats in the pool.
Yesterday he **sank** his small boat.
He has **sunk** many toys in the water.

61. bring - brought - brought

I usually **bring** my lunch to school.
Yesterday I **brought** an umbrella.
I have never **brought** my laptop

62. hear - heard - heard

I always **hear** birds in the morning.
Yesterday I **heard** a strange noise.
I have never **heard** that sound before.
